12th APPES Fellows Meeting Xi'an, China - November 14th to 17th, 2010

APPES is pleased to announce the 12th APPES Fellows' Meeting, which will be held in conjunction with the Chinese Medical Association. This is a 3 day interactive workshop for trainees in pediatric endocrinology from the Asia-Pacific Region. It is a wonderful opportunity for intensive education and interaction with colleagues and faculty from countries within region. APPES recognizes the support from Merck Serono and Pfizer and their contribution to the success of the fellows school.

Course objectives:

- To provide up to date postgraduate education for medical trainees in pediatric endocrinology from the Asia Pacific Region, covering major areas of pediatric endocrinology and diabetes. The course is designed for fellows who are pediatric endocrine trainees (not qualified endocrinologists). Applicants should have a reasonable amount of clinical experience.
- To enhance learning through a variety of education formats including case presentations, interactive small group discussion, problem-based tutorials, evidence-based learning, lectures by faculty and an endocrine quiz.
- To promote understanding about variable disease presentation and management in the region.

Location and Dates:

The 3 day course will be held from Sunday 14th to Wednesday 17th November 2010 in Xi'an, China.

Participants and Faculty:

The meeting will involve approximately 35 trainees and experienced teaching faculty from across the region, including invited speakers from the APPES Annual Scientific Meeting, which will be held immediately after the fellows' school.

How to apply:

Applications open in April 2010 and close on 31st July 2010. Application forms will be available on the APPES website, www.appes.org from 1st April 2010. Fellows who wish to apply should complete the application form and provide a Curriculum Vitae (maximum 2 pages). Factors considered in the selection process include (i) training needs, (ii) submission of an abstract to the APPES Scientific Meeting. Fellows who have attended a previous APPES fellows school are welcome to apply, although preference will be given to those who have not. Fellows must be members of APPES to attend.
